Dear Governor Kitzhaber,

My name is Rick Wallaert and I am the Northwest Contracting Manager for United Seating and Mobility; a statewide provider of customized wheelchairs (Complex Rehab Technology) for the severely disabled children and adults covered under Oregon DMAP.

We have six locations that serve Oregon communities. Our service area includes all of Northern Oregon, from the coast through the communities of Portland, Hood River, The Dalles, Pendleton, La Grande, and Ontario. We serve the entire Willamette Valley from Portland through the communities of Salem, Eugene, Grants Pass, Medford and Ashland. We also serve Central and Eastern Oregon including the communities of Klamath Falls, Bend and Redmond.

It has come to our attention that the State of Oregon is looking for savings for DME and believes it can be achieved at 70% of 2010 Medicare. This may be true for HME/DME ancillary services but is not the case relative to Complex Rehab Technology. This technology is used by individuals with conditions different from the traditional elderly Medicare population. This population group, who tend to qualify for Medicare based on their disability and not their age, consists of individuals with Cerebral palsy, Muscular Dystrophy, Spinal Cord Injury, Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis (Lou Gehrig's disease) and Spina Bifida. Complex Rehab Technology requires a much broader range of services than what is required in the provision of standard HME/DME.

I am reaching out to you to ask that you delay the proposed reduction for complex mobility products. This cut is scheduled to take effect August 1, 2011. Unfortunately, this strategy will have a devastating impact on the clients we serve. I want to be very clear that we are not suggesting we be completely exempted from any reduction; what I am proposing is delaying the reduction on a specific group of products within the DME benefit for 90 days, should we not be able to come to some agreement with the department within the next two weeks.

As you may be aware, CMS carved out Complex Rehab Technology and Congress specifically exempted it from further reduction and the competitive bid process in 2009 (bill HR6331). Similar to Orthotics & Prosthetic services, they recognized it as providing the most cost effective solution to the severely disabled. By providing access to the appropriate technology and keeping them in the home rather than institutional settings, their needs are met without creating much larger financial burdens or medical costs. It is clear that the complex mobility industry, as a whole, is under significant financial strain. Any reduction below 100% of 2011 Medicare and 80% of MSRP for unlisted codes cannot be absorbed and will eliminate the provision of Complex Rehab Technology from Oregon Medicaid benefits. If you look at the specific codes relative to Complex Rehab Technology expenditures over the last couple years you will see complex mobility is not an inflationary service.

United Seating & Mobility is also contracted with many of the Medicaid managed care plans in Oregon. Should these health plans adopt this payment schedule, we would be forced to discontinue services to open card DMAP patients and terminate our agreements with these plans.

We are fully aware of the current financial crises and the need to reduce wherever possible. We support adopting the 2010 Medicare fees for complex rehab, balanced with further reductions of several high utilization billable codes in the Group 2 power wheelchair category. While this will dramatically narrow product choice, it will still allow access to appropriate technology and repair services.

Currently, we have over 160 orders in process for the delivery of complex wheelchairs as well as repairs. Without a delay or an agreement, we will have no choice but to limit our repairs to emergency life threatening situations for a few weeks and suspend services to some 800 clients. Beginning Monday, August 1, 2011, we will have to cancel over 70 wheelchair orders and cease all repair work for the hundreds of complex wheelchairs we repair every month. We have no desire to take this step but are left with no options as we can't operate at a loss. I'm confident no one has any intention of creating an access and mobility crises for the severely disabled population in our state. I remain hopeful that a clear appreciation for the challenges we face providing these products and services, as well as how critical it is for this population to access these products and services, will allow for a quick resolution.

Attached, please find a proposal outlining our recommendation for savings as well as a spreadsheet with the proposed allowables. This same spreadsheet includes all the products we would like to have delayed if we can't resolve this quickly.

I am hopeful you will be supportive of our savings strategy; it is a sustainable solution which allows the state to continue a vital service that is a part of the DME benefit.
