LEGAL NOTICE OF PROPOSED CLASS ACTION SETTLEMENT AND HEARING

This Notice is being published by order of the United States District Court for the Middle District of Louisiana to inform you of the proposed settlement of a class action lawsuit against the Secretary of Louisiana Department of Health and Louisiana Department of Health (*A.J. v. Gee*, Case No. 19-324). The case, *A.J. v. Gee*, was filed on behalf of current and future:

Louisiana Medicaid recipients under the age of 21 who receive Medicaid Waivers on the basis of their developmental disabilities and who are authorized for Medicaid in-home nursing services such as Extended Home Healthcare and Intermittent Nursing Services, which do not require prior authorization.

The parties to that lawsuit have agreed to the proposed Settlement Agreement that, if approved by the Court, would provide certain rights and benefits to eligible individuals.

The Court will hold a hearing to consider whether to approve the proposed Settlement Agreement on _____ at _____ :00 a.m. before the Honorable Brian Jackson, United States District Judge, in the Russell B. Long Federal Building, 777 Florida Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana 70801.

Who is Included? You are a Class Member whose rights may be affected by the proposed Settlement Agreement if you currently are or will be a child under the age of 21 years old that receives a Medicaid Waiver on the basis of your disability who is also authorized for in-home nursing services but are not receiving some or all of the in-home nursing services for which you are authorized. If you are the parent of a child who is a Class Member, the lawsuit may affect the rights of your child.

What Does the Proposed Settlement Provide? The parties have asked the Court to approve a Settlement Agreement that, if approved, would provide certain rights and benefits (as more fully described in the proposed Settlement Agreement) to eligible Class Members. The Settlement Agreement generally sets forth a graduated process for the Defendants to identify the reasons why a Class Member may not be receiving their authorized in-home nursing services and remedies intended to address those reasons.
